



Murcia Regional Library, at the head of Murcia Public Libraries Network, works for the preservation and diffusion of the documentary heritage of the *Comunidad Autónoma de Murcia* (Autonomous Region of Murcia).

As part of its duties, the Regional Library supports and coordinates the library services in the region by means of the *Mapa de Lectura Pública* (Public Reading Map) and the *Guía de Recursos Bibliotecarios* (Library Resources Guide) that it regularly produces and publishes. It also functions as a link between the computer systems of the regional and national libraries networks.

Murcia Regional Library aims to be a model for the rest of the libraries in the regional network and to serve as a professional and technological advisory centre for them.
